

- . There is no indication for public shaving or a predelivery enema.
- · Pregnant women should not be put in a lithotomy (flat on the back) position during labor or delivery. They should be encouraged to walk during labor and each woman must freely decide which position to adopt during delivery.
- . The healthy newborn must remain with mother, whenever both their conditions porocess of observation of the healthy new justifies a separation from the mother.
- The immediate beginning of breastfeed be promoted, even before the mother leave delivery room.













